1. Purpose

Orbitel.ai believes in full transparency regarding the third-party vendors and subprocessors that support its operations.

This statement outlines Orbitel's vendor due diligence process, subprocessor categories, and data protection expectations.

2. Vendor Classification

Orbitel categorizes vendors and subprocessors into the following groups:

1. **Infrastructure Providers** – Cloud hosting, compute, storage, and network services.
2. **Communication and Productivity Tools** – Email, CRM, chat, and customer support platforms.
3. **Analytics and Monitoring Services** – Tools used for performance optimization and incident detection.
4. **Compliance and Security Vendors** – Providers of vulnerability scanning, audit, and compliance automation tools.

3. Due Diligence and Contractual Controls

Before onboarding any vendor or subprocessor, Orbitel conducts a detailed assessment that includes:

- Review of **ISO 27001, SOC 2, or equivalent certifications**.
- Evaluation of data protection policies and regulatory compliance (GDPR, DPDP, etc.).

- Contractual clauses mandating:
 - Confidentiality and restricted data access.
 - Encryption and security controls.
 - Timely breach reporting and cooperation in investigations.
 - Data deletion upon termination.

Vendors failing to meet Orbitel's standards are not approved.

5. Change Notification

Orbitel will notify customers at least **30 days in advance** of any addition or replacement of subprocessors.

Customers may object to a new subprocessor if they have legitimate data protection concerns.

6. Data Security and Monitoring

- All subprocessors operate under written data processing agreements with Orbitel.
- Access is strictly limited to data necessary to provide the contracted service.
- Regular audits and reviews verify continued compliance.

7. Data Transfer Safeguards

- Subprocessors outside India or the EU use **Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)** or equivalent safeguards.
- Orbitel ensures encryption and security monitoring for all cross-border data flows.

8. Contact and Updates

Orbitel maintains transparency through a dedicated Trust Center section listing current subprocessors and their purposes.
